
Tuesday 22 April (First Day of Term 2) Easter Extravaganza

The Victorian Premiers' Reading Challenge is now open and St Anthony's is excited to be participating. This is a fantastic reading initiative run by the Victorian Government to promote a love for literature and is a wonderful opportunity for students to engage in reading during the school term as well as the school holidays. This year's theme is "20 years of Words and Wonder"

The Challenge is open to all Victorian children from birth to Year 10 in recognition of the importance of reading for literacy development. It is not a competition; but a personal challenge for children to read a set number of books by **5th September 2025**. Children from Prep to Year 2 are encouraged to read or 'experience' 30 books with their parents and teachers ('experiencing' a book can include a range of home activities such as a shared reading, listening and reading along with a text and being read to). Children from Year 3 to Year 10 are challenged to read 15 books. Home readers can be counted towards the amount of books read.

All children who meet the Challenge will receive a certificate of achievement signed by the Victorian Premier and former Premiers.


